




TEACHING GUIDE FOR RESEARCH (BEFORE the webinar)

1. Say hi!	
<p>Work in class</p>  <p>Bring...</p> <p>3 white cardboard in A2</p> <p>3 different fruits with different shapes (eg. pear, apple, banana, pineapple, peach)</p> <p>1 small knife</p> <p>Student materials</p> <p>Video: The mission by Vandkunsten</p> <p>Hand out: Family (3 copies in A3)</p> <p>Poster: Mood Board (1 copy in A3)</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Divide the class into three productive teams and set up three working areas for the groups. 2. Prepare the class for the Nordic CRAFT project. What is going to happen? What is a webinar? Which country are we working with? Our role as an architect? Competition? Let the students watch the video where Vandkunsten present the mission. 3. Introduce the Mood Board by showing them the example, and hand out "cardboard" and "Family" for each group. Each group makes a Mood Board presenting: A) the family (the customer) who shall live in the sustainable house: Let the groups decide the members of the family and their needs. B) the shape of their house in a sectional drawing: - They decide the shape of their house by picking a fruit. - They cut their fruit in half and explores the shape, color, aroma, taste, feeling of the material etc. - They draw a sectional drawing of their fruit/house. C) the location of their house: Place the fruit at a typical location in your local area. Show the characteristics of the location - soil and weather conditions, vegetation, materials, colors by taking close-up-pictures, videos, drawings etc. Let the students bring back materials for the next task. <hr/> 4. The class has an online-meeting with their partner class in eg. Twinspace or Skype. - They make a presentation of the class, school, town, country. - They present their Mood Boards. <hr/> 5. Share a picture of the class and your 3 Mood Boards to the shared <u>padlet</u> no later than monday the 16. nov.
Product	3 Mood Boards presenting the family, the shape and the location of the sustainable house. Share it on <u>padlet</u> .

A moodboard (a 'mood or inspiration board') is a kind of collage of different materials - eg images, texts, colors, objects , drawings - with the purpose of conveying a mood, an impression, a style or an area in a simple and clear way for the inspiration for a group of people who need to work further on with the topic.
